Feeling ill can happen anytime. A Landmark provider or nurse is available to take your call day or night, on weekends, and on all holidays.









#### **Routine Visits**

- Discuss your health goals, answer questions, and help you manage your conditions.
- Review your medicines and teach you how to take them properly.
- Discuss advance directives, palliative care or hospice options, if needed.
- Refer you to specialists, if needed.



### **Urgent Visits**

- Visit you at home on an urgent basis, to help you avoid unneeded trips to the emergency room.
- Ask you about your symptoms.
- Provide urgent services, such as:
  - IV fluids or medicines
  - Lab draws
  - Respiratory treatments



#### **Post-hospital Visits**

- Help explain your test results.
- Review your discharge instructions, restrictions, and changes to your medicines.
- Help you get any needed in-home health services, such as:
  - Physical therapy
  - Visiting nurses
  - Social workers

Before your Landmark provider leaves your home, they will ask to schedule your next visit.

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# **Your Landmark Care Team**

Landmark will typically visit you four or more times a year, depending on your health needs. Each visit has an important purpose.

The person who visits you may vary based on the services you need.



#### Your care team includes:

AAC I	Doctors, Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants	Collaborate with your current doctors to provide preventive and urgent medical care in your home.
	Health Care Ambassadors	Offer support by phone and in your home as you work toward goals. They check in with you between provider visits.
**	Social Workers	Connect you and your family with community resources and help you access benefits.
	Dietitians	Teach you how food can impact your health, including diet recommendations for your health conditions.
	Nurse Care Managers	Serve as your point of contact by phone, check on you between visits, and help you coordinate your care.
	Pharmacists	Review your medicines, answer your questions, and help identify lower-cost prescription options.
P <sub>k</sub>	Behavioral Health (Psychiatric NP or Psychiatrist)	Assess your needs, provide short-term treatment, support ongoing treatment, and help you manage your medications
